INFRACTION

Destruction or Theft

Use of Illegal Drugs
and for Alcoholic Beverages

Fighting

“Boom Boxes”, radios, etc.
ARE NOT to be played in
public areas (Halls, lobbies, etc.)

Broken Curfew

PENALTY

Restitution for damages AND suspension
for not less than one (1) WRJT tournament.

Indefinite Suspension

Local Law Enforcement Officers will be
called. Juniors may be subject to arrest

Suspension for not less than two (2)
WRJT tournaments.

Local Law Enforcement Officers will be
called. Juniors may be subject to arrest.

Confiscation until departure

Suspension for not less than one (1) WRJT
tournament.

If there are any damages to individual rooms, the guilty parties will pay for the damages. Additionally, the guilty parties will be suspended from the WRJT for not less than one (1) tournament. Also, if there are any general damages in the hotel and the guilty parties CANNOT be determined, the cost will be divided among the Senates lodging at the hotel. If restitution is not made, the groups involved will be suspended until such time as payment is made. The WRJT Committee reserves all rights and any decisions rendered will be final.
