

TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

(Read these Rules and Regulations carefully)

FAILURE TO READ IS NO EXCUSE

1. Participants must be sanctioned in The National Bowling Association Junior Program and the United States Bowling Congress. **PLEASE INCLUDE COPY OF USBC CERTIFICATION LIST.**
2. **Only BANTAMS (8 & under) are eligible for this event. No one born on or before August 1, 2007 is eligible to participate.**
3. Entrants must use their highest league average based on a minimum of seven (7) league sessions.
 - a. A participant who has **NOT** bowled the required minimum sessions **WILL** bowl scratch.
 - b. Scratch is defined as follows:

	Boys	Girls
Bantam (8 & under)	130	110
4. **LEAGUE STANDING SHEET MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRIES. AVERAGES AS OF JANUARY 31 OF THE CURRENT SEASON WILL BE USED.**
5. Coaches must check in at least one (1) hour prior to scheduled time to bowl.
 - a. Proof of sanction (TNBA & USBC cards) must be shown at check-in.
 - b. Tardy bowlers must begin the event in the frame being bowled. All missed frames will receive zero (0).
6. Participants must be listed on a league standing sheet.
7. Participants may bowl only **ONCE** in this event.
8. Handicap will be 100% of the difference in individual's average and scratch.
9. Participants will bowl three (3) games on one (1) pair of lanes.
10. One award per eight (8) entries will be awarded. Duplicate awards will be given in cases of ties. Award fees will be returned 100%.
11. Bowlers must stay in the settee area while bowling unless excused by scorekeeper or tournament monitor.
 - a. There will be no food or drinks in the settee area.
 - b. Bowlers must wear suitable attire. Hats, halters, tank-tops, and clothing with inappropriate language **MAY NOT** be worn during tournament play.
12. Violation of any rules or falsification on any entry will result in automatic disqualification with **NO** refund of entry fee.
13. All decisions of the tournament manager are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329.
14. **Coaches are responsible for all TNBA and USBC award applications.**

THERE IS TO BE NO COACHING OF JUNIORS IN THE BOWLING AREA.
