**ENTRY FORM AND RULES ON BACK**

**TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS**  
**(Failure To Read Is No Excuse)**

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** - Open to all 2018-2019 TNBA members who are certified by USBC. **No temporary receipts will be accepted (unless can be verified).** No cards sold day of tournament, and cards must be presented at check-in.
2. **Entry Closing Date** – All entries mailed must be fully paid to the Tournament Director by February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 or the first 78 Senior Men/women **50 - 59** years of age and 30 Super Senior men/women **60** years and older. All completed entries must be accompanied by certified check or money order. **(NO PERSONAL CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED).** Walk-in Entries will be accepted up until **10 pm Friday February 15, 2019** for seniors & super seniors, providing spots are available. If less than 78 Senior Men and 30 Super Senior enter, prize fund will only be reduced by the prize fees of the number not participating.
3. **CANCELATION POLICY:** A refund minus \$20.00 processing fee will be made for cancellations made prior to 72 hours of the start of the tournament. There will be **NO REFUNDS** without a replacement with-in 72 hours of the tournament minus a \$20.00 processing fee.  
**THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS FOR NO SHOWS.**
4. **TOURNAMENT FORMAT:**
  - a) Senior Men and Super Senior Men will bowl two (2) four (4) game blocks.
  - b) Field is then cut 40%. Based on highest pinfall for eight (8) games. The remaining Senior Men and Super Senior Men will bowl a four (4) game block.
  - c) The field is then cut to the money round 12 senior men and 6 super senior men (Based on Entries), highest scores based on 78 senior men and 30 super senior men. The men will bowl a three (3) game block.
  - d) The cut to the top five (4) bowlers, who are finalist, will be determined by the total pinfall for fifteen (15) games for seniors & super seniors. These bowlers will play stair-step position, starting with the fourth (4<sup>th</sup>) place bowler, who plays the third (3<sup>rd</sup>) place bowler etc.
  - e) The final roll-off game between the top two (2) finalists in each division, for the championship, will be bowled on a neutral pair of lanes.
  - f) In case of a tie for first place, there will be two (2) additional frames 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> frames bowled until the tie is broken. This rule also applies for all ties in the money rounds. **In event of a tie for the 1<sup>st</sup> cut score, all bowlers with the same score will advance to the next round. (This applies to the 1<sup>st</sup> cut only!).**
5. **DRESS CODE:** All entrants are **REQUIRED** to wear a collared shirt with participant's name on the back must worn during each round of competition. Mock turtle-necks or bowling jerseys without collars are allowed. Full name or last name on a detachable name plaque accepted. Paper name plaques not accepted. Tank tops, halter tops, or tee-shirts, jeans or denim material (of any color), sweats, spandex (pants/skirts) will not be allowed. Women may wear capri pants, skirts, culottes, shorts/skorts that extend beyond their fingers when their arms are extended down by their sides. Bowlers may not wear headgear of any kind. There will be a \$25.00 fee per squad for any infraction of this rule. **THIS RULE WILL BE ENFORCED.**
6. **PROFESSIONAL BOWLERS:** Current PBA Senior members regardless of classification will not be permitted to bowl in TNBA Tournaments. **Past PBA Senior champions regardless of classification, may be permitted to bowl if their championship was not within the last 8 years.** Former PBA Senior members who have not held a card for one (1) year are eligible to bowl in TNBA Classic tournaments.
- 6a **Due to the significant attention and substantial platform of the PWBA, as of the 2017-18 bowling season and to continue TNBA consistency with current TNBA rules on PBA/Senior PBA. Special rule from 2015-16 season that permitted current PWBA/PWBA Senior members to bowl in TNBA Classic Tournaments will no longer be in effect.**
7. Prize fund will be paid 100%. Prize fund will be at least one (1) prize for every eight (8) entries.
8. **Any bowler who qualifies for total winnings of \$600.00 or more in the tournament must provide a tax identification number to receive awarded prize(s).**
9. Premature termination of the tournament brought about by war, national emergency or emergency causes relating thereto or there from; fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other reasons beyond the control of **The Game Entertainment** shall cause the foregoing prize schedule to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled.
10. All rules not stated above will be governed by TNBA and USBC rules.
11. In the event any bowler fails to report on time, the Director reserves the right to replace him/her with another bowler to complete the field, only at the start of the tournament. Tardy bowlers will receive zero (0) each frame missed, making up frames will not be allowed.
12. Anyone employed at **The Game Entertainment and their affiliates** from January 1, 2019 until the tournament is not eligible to bowl in this Classic.
13. **Early bird special – Entries postmarked or received by December 31, 2018 are eligible for a 20% discount on their entry fee.**
14. The Tournament Committee will make all decisions and reserves the right to refuse or reject any entry.
