

**TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS**  
(Read these Rules and Regulations carefully)

## FAILURE TO READ IS NO EXCUSE

Members of the National Bowling Association Junior Program and United States Bowling Congress under the direction of the Eastern Regional Senate or groups are eligible to enter this tournament.

1. **SANCTION CARDS**- Every Jr. Bowler that is bowling in the tournament must have a TNBA and USBC sanction card. These cards will not be available for purchase on site and must be secured prior to the processing of the tournament entries. If you need a TNBA card or additional information, you are to contact Veronica Green, TNBA Junior Program Director. Her mailing address is P O Box 161839, Atlanta, GA 30321-1839 and her telephone number is (678) 232-1194. The cost of a TNBA card is \$10.00. If you need USBC information, please contact your local USBC office.
2. Bowlers of different age divisions may bowl together.
  - a. Teams may be all boys, all girls, or mixed.
  - b. Each bowler may enter each event twice, with a change of 1 member on the team and doubles. Bowlers may only place once in singles.
  - c. **Membership is open to youth who have not yet reached their 20<sup>th</sup> birthday as of August 1<sup>st</sup> of the new season**
3. Entrants must use their highest league average based on a minimum of seven (7) league sessions.
  - a. A participant who has not bowled the required minimum sessions will bowl scratch.
  - b. Scratch is defined as follows:

Seniors (15-20)	210	190

- c. Handicap will be based on 100% of difference in team total and scratch within classes as follows:

4. **LEAGUE STANDING SHEETS MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRIES. AVERAGES AS OF JANUARY 31st OF THE CURRENT SEASON WILL BE USED. SPORTS AVERAGES WILL BE ACCEPTED but will be adjusted according to the Sport League Average Adjustment Chart from USBC. It is the coaches' responsibility to notify the Director if a Sports league average is used. PLEASE INCLUDE COPY OF USBC CERTIFICATION LIST.**
5. Bowlers will bowl three (3) games on one pair of lanes for each event. Bowlers will bowl in the same order listed on entry form. Bowlers cannot bowl Optional Singles without bowling Doubles. The Doubles score will also count as the Singles score.
6. Substitutes will be allowed. Reclassifications may be in order due to the use of a substitute.
  - a. Substitutes must be listed on a league standing sheet.
  - b. Once a substitute starts to bowl, he/she must complete all three (3) games.
  - c. All substitution changes must be completed one (1) hour prior to squad start time.
7. Team Captains with no substitution changes must check in at least thirty (30) minutes prior to squad start time.
  - a. Proof of sanction (TNBA & USBC cards) must be provided prior to check-in.
  - b. Tardy bowlers must begin the event in the frame being bowled. All missed frames will receive zero (0).
  - c. No blind scores will be allowed.

8. One award per eight (8) entries per event per class will be awarded. Duplicate awards will be given in case of ties. Award fees will be returned 100%.
9. Bowlers are required to dress in a suitable manner. Hats, short-shorts, halters, tank-tops, and clothing with inappropriate language **ARE NOT** allowed during tournament play.
10. Bowlers must stay in the settee area while bowling, unless excused by scorekeeper or tournament official.
  - a. Any junior bowler smoking during tournament play will be disqualified.
  - b. There will be no food or drinks in the settee area.
  - c. **No coaching allowed in the bowling settee area. Parents/Coaches must remain in the spectator's area.**
11. Violation of any rules or falsification on any entry will result in automatic disqualification of the team, with **NO** refund of entry fee.
12. All decisions of the tournament manager are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329.
13. This tournament will be a Junior Gold Qualifier (see ERJT Junior Gold Flyer) consisting of six games. All entrants must be Junior Gold members prior to bowling. Membership can be purchased on site.
14. **Coaches are responsible for all TNBA and USBC award applications.**
15. **ABSOLUTELY NO** outside food and/or drink will be allowed into the Bowling Center. Anyone caught in violation of this rule will be asked to leave the bowling center immediately (no Refunds given).

### INFORMATION FOR COACHES

#### BE SURE:

- to put your name, complete address, phone number, and email address (if available) on each entry form. **Please print or type.**
- to mark your desired date(s) & time(s) to bowl. (including second choice)
- all team entries have team names.
- to submit the name, average, sex, birth date, TNBA & USBC card number and league standing sheet for each bowler along with proper payment/fees.
- that all names are legible and correct (no nicknames). You know your bowlers, the Tournament Director does not.
- to notify the tournament director of any changes as soon as possible. This will speed up check-in as well as allow time to make corrections and/or adjustments.
- that bowlers and parents are aware of dress code and tournament rules.
- to keep a copy of entries for your records.
