TOURNAMENT RULES

(Failure to Read Is No Excuse)

TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

(Failure to Read Is No Excuse)

- ELIGIBILITY:** This event is open to all 2024-2025 TNBA members who are certified by USBC. No temporary receipts will be accepted (unless they can be verified). No cards are sold on-site the day of the tournament, and cards must be presented at check-in.
- Entry Closing Date** – All entries mailed must be fully paid to the Tournament Director by Feb 14th, 2025, or the first 114 men 18 years and older & 60 women 18 years and older. Men Senior division the first 70 ages 50-59, Super Senior division the first 40 ages 60 and older, & the senior women's division the first 60 ages 50 and older. A certified check or money order must accompany all completed entries. **(NO PERSONAL CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED)**. Walk-in Entries will be accepted up until **10 pm Friday, Feb 14, 2025**, providing spots are available.
- CANCELATION POLICY:** A refund minus a **\$20.00** processing fee will be made for cancellations made prior to 72 hours of the start of the tournament. There will be **NO REFUNDS** without a replacement within 72 hours of the tournament, minus a **\$20.00** processing fee. **THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS FOR NO SHOWS.**
- TOURNAMENT FORMAT:**
 - Men and Women will bowl two (2) five (5) game blocks. All Senior divisions will bowl two (2) four (4) game blocks
 - The Field is then cut to the top 40%. Based on the highest pinfall for ten (10) games and eight (8) for Seniors. The remaining Men and Women will bowl a five (5) game block, and Seniors a 4-game block.
 - The field is then cut to the money round of 16 men and 12 women (Based on Entries), with the highest scores based on 120 men and 60 women. The men and women will bowl a four (4) game block. Seniors will bowl a three (3) game block.
 - The cut to the top five (5) bowlers who are finalists will be determined by the total pinfall for nineteen (19) games for men and women. Seniors based on fifteen (15) games. These bowlers will play stair-step position, starting with the fifth (5th) place bowler, who plays the fourth (4th) place bowler etc.
 - The final roll-off game between the top two (2) finalists in each division, for the championship, will be bowled on a neutral pair of lanes.
 - In case of a tie for first place, there will be two (2) additional frames, 9th and 10th, bowled until the tie is broken. This rule also applies to all ties in the money rounds. **In the event of a tie for the 1st cut score, all bowlers with the same score will advance to the next round. (This applies to the 1st cut only!).**
- DRESS CODE:** All entrants are **REQUIRED** to wear a collared shirt with the participant's name on the back, which must be worn during each round of competition. Mock turtlenecks or bowling jerseys without collars are allowed. Full name or last name on a detachable name plaque accepted. Paper name plaques are not accepted. Tank tops, halter tops, tee shirts, jeans or denim material (of any color), sweats, and spandex (pants/skirts) will not be allowed. Women may wear capri pants, skirts, culottes, shorts/skorts that extend beyond their fingers when their arms are extended down by their sides. Bowlers may not wear headgear of any kind. There will be a \$25.00 fee per squad for any infraction of this rule. **THIS RULE WILL BE ENFORCED.**
- PROFESSIONAL BOWLERS:** Current or past PBA members will be permitted to bowl in TNBA tournaments if they have not achieved the following: (a) top 40 on PBA tour money or point list in the past three years; (b) won a PBA tour title in past seven years; (c) top 20 on PBA Regional tour money or point list; (d) won a PBA Regional tour title in the past four years. PBA50 and WPBA members will be permitted to bowl, providing they have not achieved the following: (a) top 20 on PBA50/WPBA tour money or point list in the past two years; (b) won a PBA50/WPBA tour title in past four years; (c) top 10 on PBA50/WPBA Regional tour money or point list; (d) won a PBA Regional tour title in past two years.
- GENDER CLASSIFICATION:** USBC's gender classification is based on IOC guidelines approved in 2015 and a subsequent IOC framework on inclusion and non-discrimination based on gender identity and sex variations announced in 2021.
- The prize fund will be paid 100%. There will be at least one (1) prize for every six (6) entries.
- Any bowler who qualifies for total winnings of \$600.00 or more in the tournament must provide a tax identification number to receive prize(s) winnings.**
- Premature termination of the tournament brought about by war, national emergency, or emergency causes relating thereto or therefrom; fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties, or other reasons beyond the control of **Bowlero Lanes** shall cause the foregoing prize schedule to be prorated per the number of entrants who have bowled.
- All rules not stated above will be governed by TNBA and USBC rules.
- In the event any bowler fails to report on time, the Director reserves the right to replace him/her with another bowler to complete the field, only at the start of the tournament. Tardy bowlers will receive zero (0) each frame missed, making up frames will not be allowed.
- Early bird special – Entries postmarked or received by Jan 14, 2025, are eligible for a \$20.00 discount on their entry.**
- The Tournament Committee will make all decisions and reserves the right to refuse or reject any entry.
