WESTERN REGIONAL JUNIOR TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

(Read these Rules and Regulations carefully)

FAILURE TO READ IS NO EXCUSE

Members of the National Bowling Association Junior Program and United States Bowling Congress under the direction of the western Region or groups are eligible to participate in this tournament. This tournament is governed by the National Bowling Association (TNBA) and United States Bowling Congress (USBC)

NO ENTRIES ACCEPTED AT TOURNAMENT SITE. Any entries received after midnight, March 23, 2024, may be returned. All entries must show team name, the bowler's full legal name (No Nicknames), sex, average as of 2-28-24 birth date, age as of 8-01-23, TNBA and USBC certification numbers. Any entries improperly filled out, missing signed parent permission forms, league standing sheets, USBC certification list, or the improper amount of fees will not be accepted, and will be returned to the sender. No entry money will be returned for any reason after the closing date. IF AN ENTRY IS RECEIVED AFTER THE DEADLINE A LATE FEE OF TWENTY-FIVE (\$25.00) DOLLARS MUST BE PAID BEFORE THE ENTRIES ARE PROCESSED.

1. Participants must be certified in The National Bowling Association Junior Program and United States Bowling Congress prior to bowling. PLEASE INCLUDE A COPY OF USBC CERTIFICATION LIST from the USBC site.

2. Bowlers of different age divisions may bowl as a team. Bantams (8 and under) are allowed to bowl team event.

a. Teams must consist of 4 actual bowlers, and may be all boys, all girls, or mixed.

b. Each bowler may enter ONLY ONCE in each event.

Bowlers must bowl in the order listed on the entry. Entire line-ups cannot be changed nor can bowlers be transferred from one team to another unless a complete team is being dissolved.

3. Entrants must use their highest average based on a minimum of 21 games or USBC average of 2022/23.

a. A participant who has not bowled the required minimum games will bowl scratch. b. Sc

Scratch is defined	as follows:

c. Handicap will be based on 100% of the difference in team total and scratch within classes as follows:

4. League standing sheets must accompany entries. USBC league averages as of February 28th of the current season will be used. PLEASE INCLUDE A COPY OF USBC CERTIFICATION LIST from the USBC site. Sports averages will be used if it is the only league that the bowler bowls. Such must be noted on the entry and the average will be converted according to USBC standards.

5. Bowlers will bowl five (5) games on one pair of lanes for the five-game set, games 1-3 for team scores, 2-4 for doubles scores, 3-5 for singles scores. Bowlers 8 and under will bowl three (3) games on one pair of lanes. Bowlers will bowl in the same order listed on the entry form. 6. Substitutes will be allowed. Reclassification may occur due to the use of a substitute. All substitution forms must be completed one (1) hour prior to the starting squad time.

a. Substitutes MUST be listed on a league standing sheet.

b. Once a substitute starts to bowl, he/she must complete all five (5) games or three (3) games.

7. Coaches/Team Captains must check in, with no substitutions, at least 30 minutes prior to scheduled time to bowl.

a. Proof of certification (TNBA & USBC cards) must be provided prior to check-in.

b. Tardy bowlers must begin the event in the frame being bowled. All missed frames will receive zero (0).

If a team refuses to start because a full line up is not present, they shall forfeit all games that they decline to bowl.

c. No blind scores shall be permitted.

8. Award fees will be returned 100%. In cases of ties the awards will be given to the highest actual pin fall. In the event of a championship tie the winner will be determined by greatest total of actual pin fall.

9. Bowlers are required to dress in a suitable manner. No Jeans Only bowling shirts or polo shirts with collars may be worn. Mock neck bowling shirts are acceptable. All shirts must have TNBA Senate or WRJT on them. No lead gear, electronic or telephone equipment of any kind may be

worn during tournament play. Failure to adhere to the dress code could result in disgualification and the bowler WILL be required to leave the lanes. 10.

- Bowlers must stay in the settee area while bowling, unless excused by scorekeeper or tournament monitor.
 - a. Any bowler smoking during tournament play will be disgualified.
 - b. There will be no food or drinks in the sitting area.

Coaching is definitely not allowed in the bowling area. Parents and coaches must remain in the spectator's section.

11. Violation of any rules or falsification on any entry will result in automatic disgualification of the team or bowler with NO refund of entry fee.

12. The Tournament Committee reserves all rights. Any decision they render will be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329 (Protest & Appeals). 13. Coaches are responsible for all TNBA and USBC award applications.

INFORMATION FOR COACHES

BE SURE:

- to put names (No Nicknames), complete address, phone number, and email address (if available) on each entry form or permission form. Please print legible or type.

- to remember ENTRIES WILL BE SCHEDULED ON A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE BASIS.

- all entries have team names and captains listed.
- to record the average, sex. TNBA & USBC certification number, and birth date for each bowler.

that all names are legible and correct (no nicknames).

- to notify the Tournament Director of any changes as soon as possible. This will speed up check-in as well as allow time to make corrections and/or adjustments.

- that bowlers are aware of the dress code and tournament rules.
- that the total entry fee accompanies the entry form, and all certified checks and money orders are made payable to: TNBA Junior Program (reference: WRJT). Do not remit cash. (No League, Company or Personal Checks accepted)
- to keep a copy of entries for your records.

REMEMBER: If you submit an incomplete entry, it may be returned. The FULL ENTRY FEE must be submitted! ALSO DON'T FORGET TO ENCLOSE A COPY OF USBC CERTIFICATION LIST from USBC site!
