## **Tournament Rules and Regulations**

## (Rules and Regulation apply to all entrants)

frames will be allowed.

- 1. ENTRIES CLOSE OCTOBER 4, 2024. ALL ENTRIES MUST SHOW TEAM NAME, FULL NAMES OF EACH BOWLER, TNBA AND USBC NUMBERS. ALSO SINGLES/DOUBLES ENTRY MUST BE COM-PLETED IN FULL. NO ENTRIES AT TOURNAMENT SITES.
- 2. Open to all TNBA, USBC members in the Western Region.
- 3. Bowlers may participate by purchasing a USBC Association Membership card (\$30). Non-TNBA members may qualify for entry by paying \$35.00 membership fee.
- 4. The Total Entry Fee must accompany the entry form, and all certified checks and money orders made payable to: TNBA Western Regional Tournament. DO NOT remit cash. No entry money will be returned for any reason after the closing date.
- Preferred dates will be granted when possible. When lanes are filled on requested dates, The Nearest Open Date Will Be Given. Entries will be scheduled on first come, first serve basis.
- 6. Prize fees will be returned 100%. There will be at least one (1) prize for every 8 entries. All events prize ratio is one out of every twenty (20). Bowlers may cash in both Handicap and Scratch prizes.
- 7. Teams will be paired according to pin average or prior reservations. In the singles and doubles, the lanes will be assigned by the tournament director.
- Bowlers must use their highest average based on a minimum of 21 games for the 2022-2023 or 2023-2024 seasons, whichever is highest. If no average for either season, then use the highest current sanc-tioned average of 21 or more games as of October 26, 2024 verified by a league sheet. All others bowl scratch. Summer League or Sports averages will not be accepted. Challenge averages will <u>be</u> <u>used</u> with their conversion, if that conversion is the highest average. The Ten pin rule is <u>waived</u> for this tournament.
- 9. The handicap shall be 80% using 220 scratch. Bowlers will certify their scores as being correct at the completion of each game. Handicap is on an individual basis.
- 10. A) Any man-woman combination may be used for mixed teams. Not more than three (3) players on the same team may re-enter; two (2) players must be dropped and two(2) new players added. B) When a bowler competes more than once, his/her first appearance in each event shall count toward his/her All Events score. All Events are optional with a handicap and scratch division; bowlers may enter both. C) Multiple entry will be permitted in the team events. Five men, five woman, or mixed. D) *Employees in the host bowling center may not bowl in this tournament.*
- 11. Entrants cannot enter doubles and not singles or enter singles and not doubles. You must enter both events. **Multiple entry will be permitted for singles and doubles.** You may cash only once in doubles with the same partner. **NO MIXED DOUBLES ON THIS ENTRY.**
- 12. ANY BOWLER MISREPRESENTING HIS OR HER AVERAGE TO GAIN MORE PINS SHALL FORFEIT ENTRY FEE AND ALL RIGHTS TO PRIZE MONEY (Handicap only). MAKE SURE YOUR HIGHEST AVERAGE ACCORDING TO RULES IS CORRECT BEFORE ENTERING.
- All winners will be checked with proper affidavits before awarding any prizes. <u>Bowlers placed on the prize</u> <u>list averages will be verified by Bowl.com.</u> **THIS RULE WILL BE ENFORCED.** All winners must have current TNBA memberships prior to bowling. Failure to do so, will result in disqualification.
- 14. In the event of a tie, teams shall be declared co-champions.
- 15. <u>It shall be the responsibility of each bowler to verify the accuracy of his or her average, whether originally submitted by the bowler, his or her captain or anyone other person.</u>
- 16. Failure to use the proper average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than the actual average thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the actual average, than the bowler must live with assigned handicap. Any protest pertaining to the prize fund results must be received and post marked within five (5) days after the distribution of the unofficial tournament results.

- 17. All bowlers must check the USBC Rule 319E "AVERAGE ADJUSTMENT". These rules apply to all participants.
- 18. Bowlers who have qualified for a prize of \$600.00 or more in any event in a tournament within the previous 12 months must report actual scores, position and amount won for possible re-rating. Any entrant having been re-rated or subject to re-rate by another tournament must report their re-rated average to the tournament director. Failure to do so will result in disqualification. USBC Rule 319E will apply.
- 19. Bowlers shall report for check-in at least one hour before the scheduled time to bowl and present their TNBA and USBC cards when requested. Any replacements must be submitted seven (7) days prior to the tournament start date. If not, bowler will be designated as a substitute. Substitutes are to be reported 30 minutes before squad starting time and cleared by the Tournament office before bowling and handicap will be adjusted accordingly.
- **20.** A) When a team captain secures a substitute, once the substitute has started to bowl, the substitute must finish the event being bowled. Substitutes must have a verified membership prior to the tournament start date or they cannot sub in the tournament.
  - B) The tournament committee reserves the right to accept or reject substitute offered by the team captain.C) Teams or individuals who fail to appear on the lanes prepared to bowl as scheduled shall forfeit their entry, subject to the discretion of the tournament committee.
  - D) Bowlers arriving late for their scheduled squad time shall receive zero (0) for frames missed. No make-up
  - E) Bowlers will certify their scores as being correct at the completion of each game.
  - F) Provisional ball or frame will be used in situation where a foul or legality of pin fall cannot be immediately resolved.

G) Errors in scoring must be reported to the Tournament Director within <u>24 hours</u> of tournament results being posted.

- **21.** No unreasonable delay in the progress of any game shall be allowed. Should any bowler or team participating in the tournament refuse to proceed with the game after being directed to do so by the proper authori-ties, such game or series shall be declared forfeited. Any bowler not ready to bowl when his or her turn comes shall be given a ZERO (0) for that frame.
- **22.** If a breakdown of the lanes occurs that exceeds ten(10) minutes, the tournament committee reserves the right to move bowlers to another pair of lanes to avoid shift delays.
- **23.** The tournament committee shall prepare the prize list after the entries are closed and the same shall be posted at the lanes where the tournament is being conducted.
- **24.** The tournament committee reserves the right to disqualify any bowler not in compliance with the rules of the tournament. The tournament will be operated under the rules of TNBA and USBC.
- 25. Proper attire is required. No head gear (hat, cap, etc.). Tournament reserves the right to final decisions on proper attire.
- 26. Premature termination of the tournament brought about by war, national emergency or emergency causes relating thereto fire, natural disaster, or any other reason beyond control of the TNBA Western Regional Tournament shall cause, the extent required hereby, all prizes to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in each of the respective events up to the time of such termination.
- 27. Any bowler winning \$600 or more will be issued an IRS W-9 BEFORE any prize winnings are paid to that bowler.
- 28. Current or past PBA members will be permitted to bowl in TNBA tournaments if they have not achieved the following: (a) top 40 on PBA tour money or point list in the past three years; (b) won a PBA tour title in past seven years; c) top 20 on PBA Regional tour money or point list; (d) won a PBA Regional tour title in past four years. PBA50 and WPBA members will be permitted to bowl providing they have not achieved the following: (a) top 20 on PBA50/WPBA tour money or point list in the past two years; (b) won a PBA50/WPBA tour title in past four years; c) top 10 on PBA50/WPBA Regional tour money or point list; (d) won a PBA Regional tour money or point list; (d) won a PBA Regional tour title in past four years; c) top 10 on PBA50/WPBA Regional tour money or point list; (d) won a PBA Regional tour title in past two years. Only one PBA bowler allowed per team.
