**EASTERN REGIONAL JUNIOR TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS
(Read these Rules and Regulations carefully)**

FAILURE TO READ IS NO EXCUSE

Members of the National Bowling Association Junior Program and United States Bowling Congress under the direction of the western Region or groups are eligible to participate in this tournament. This tournament is governed by the National Bowling Association (TNBA) and United States Bowling Congress (USBC).

NO ENTRIES ACCEPTED AT THE TOURNAMENT SITE. Any entries received after **midnight, March 25, 2025**, may be returned. All entries must show team name, the bowler's full legal name (No Nicknames), sex, average as of **02-28-2025**, birth date, age as of 8-01-24, TNBA and USBC certification numbers. Any entries improperly filled out, missing signed parent permission forms, league standing sheets, USBC certification list, or the improper amount of fees will not be accepted, and will be returned to the sender. No entry money will be returned for any reason after the closing date. IF AN ENTRY IS RECEIVED AFTER THE DEADLINE A LATE FEE OF TWENTY-FIVE (\$25.00) DOLLARS MUST BE PAID BEFORE THE ENTRIES ARE PROCESSED.

1. Participants must be certified in The National Bowling Association Junior Program and United States Bowling Congress prior to bowling. TNBA Cards may be purchased on site for \$15.00. If you need a TNBA card or additional information, you can contact **Anthony Mitchell, TNBA Junior Program Director, at PO Box 53166, Cincinnati, OH 45253** or by cell **(513)400-3816**.
2. Bowlers of different age divisions may bowl as a team. Bantams (8 and under) are allowed to bowl team event.
 - a. Teams **must consist of four (4) actual bowlers, and** may be all boys, all girls, or mixed.
 - b. Each bowler may enter **ONLY ONCE** in each event.
 - c. Bowlers must bowl in the order listed on the entry form. Entire line-ups cannot be changed, not can bowlers be transferred from one team to another unless a complete team dissolved.
 - d. Membership is open to youth who have not reached their 18th birthday as of August 1st of the current season.
3. Entrants must use their highest league average based on a minimum of 21 games or USBC book average from 2023/24.
 - a. A participant who has not bowled the required minimum games will bowl scratch.
 - b. Scratch is defined as follows:

Juniors (12-14)	190
Bantams (9-11)	160
Bantams (8 & under)	130

Handicap will be based on 100% of the difference in team total and scratch within classes as follows:

4. League standing sheets must accompany entries. USBC league averages as of February 28th of the current season will be used.
 - a. Sports averages will be used if it is the only league that the bowler bowls. Such must be noted on the entry and the average will be converted according to USBC standards.
 - b. Coaches are to submit a copy of the USBC Certification List from the USBC site.
 - c. Coaches are to submit the signed parent permission form for each bowler.
5. Bowlers will bowl three (3) games on one pair of lanes for each event. Bowlers 8 and under will bowl three (3) games on one pair of lanes. Bowlers will bowl in the same order listed on the entry form.
 - a. Bowlers who enter the doubles event must bowl singles.
 - b. Bowlers who enter the singles event must bowl doubles.
6. Substitutes will be allowed. Reclassification may occur due to the use of a substitute. All substitution forms must be completed one (1) hour prior to

- the starting squad time.
 - a. Substitutes **MUST** be listed on a league standing sheet.
 - b. Once a substitute starts to bowl, he/she must complete all games.
 - c. All substitution changes must be completed one (1) hour prior to the squad's start time.

7. Coaches/Team Captains must check in, with no substitutions, at least 30 minutes prior to scheduled time to bowl.
 - a. Proof of certification (TNBA & USBC cards) must be provided prior to check-in.
 - b. Tardy bowlers must begin the event in the frame being bowled. All missed frames will receive zero (0).
 - c. **If a team refuses to start because a full line up is not present, they shall forfeit all games that they decline to bowl.**
 - d. **No blind scores shall be permitted.**
8. Award fees will be returned 100%. In cases of ties the awards will be given to the highest actual pin fall. In the event of a championship tie the winner will be determined by the greatest total of actual pin fall.
9. Youth may participate in brackets provided, prior to bowling: All bracket entries are returned 100% in the form of scholarships only.
 - a. The parent/legal guardian or coach must complete the bracket form.
 - b. The tournament will award the youth's prize in the form of a scholarship via participant's SMART account.
10. Bowlers must compete in appropriate bowling attire. No jeans or sweats. A Bowling jersey, polo shirts or t-shirt, slacks, shorts, skirts skorts (must be longer than fingertip length when arms are hanging loosely along the sides of the body). All shirts are encouraged to have TNBA Senate or ERT on them. No head gear, electronic or telephone equipment of any kind may be worn during tournament play. Failure to adhere to the dress code could result in disqualification and the bowler WILL be required to leave the lanes.
11. Bowlers must stay in the settee area while bowling, unless excused by scorekeeper or tournament monitor.
 - a. Any bowler smoking during tournament play will be disqualified.
 - b. There will be no food or drinks in the sitting area.
 - c. No coaching allowed in the bowling settee area. Parents/Coaches must remain in the spectator's area.
12. Violation of any rules or falsification on any entry will result in automatic disqualification of the team or bowler with NO refund of entry fee.
13. The Tournament Committee reserves all rights. Any decision they render will be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329 (Protest & Appeals).
14. Coaches are responsible for all TNBA and USBC award applications.
15. No entries will be accepted at the tournament site. No entry fee money will be returned for any reason after the closing date. If an entry is received after the closing date, a late fee of twenty-five (\$25.00) must be paid prior to the entries being processed.
16. Absolutely no outside food and/or drink will be allowed into the bowling center.

**REMEMBER: If you submit an incomplete entry, it may be returned. The FULL ENTRY FEE must be submitted!
