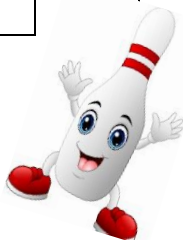

## CENTRAL REGIONAL JUNIOR TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

### FAILURE TO READ IS NO EXCUSE

Members of the National Bowling Association Junior Program and United States Bowling Congress under the direction of the Central Regional or groups are eligible to enter this tournament. This tournament is governed by the National Bowling Association (TNBA) and United States Bowling Congress (USBC).

#### Eligibility & Governance

- Open to junior members of The National Bowling Association, Inc. (TNBA) Junior Program and the United States Bowling Congress (USBC) under the direction of the TNBA Central Region.
- All participants must be ages 5-17 and must not turn 18 before September 1, 2025.
- The tournament is governed by TNBA and USBC rules.

#### Division Breakdown

##### Tournament Average

The tournament will use the following ways to determine a bowlers average that will be used for the tournament.

- a) Current season average as of 2.28.2026, after 12 games, or
- b) Last year, 2024-2025 season as per USBC, or
- c) The scratch average per your age division, as seen below:

#### Entries

##### Required Entry Information

Each entry must include:

- No on-site entries will be accepted.
- All entries are due two (2) weeks prior to the tournament: Friday, April 10, 2026.
- Bowler's full legal name (no nicknames)
- Sex
- Average as of February 28, 2026 (league standing sheets required)
- Date of birth
- Age as of August 1, 2025
- TNBA and USBC sanction numbers
- Signed parent permission form
- Correct entry fee

\*Incomplete entries will be considered invalid if not corrected by the deadline\*

##### Sanction Cards

- All bowlers must be TNBA and USBC certified prior to competition.
- USBC cards may be purchased through USBC.
- TNBA cards may be purchased through a local TNBA Junior League or by contacting:

##### General Competition Rules

- Bowlers from different age divisions may bowl together in Teams and Doubles.
- Each bowler may enter only once per event.
- Bowlers must bowl in the order listed on the entry form.
- No lineup changes will be allowed after the entry deadline.
- All participants must meet age eligibility as of September 1, 2025.

#### Handicap & Average Divisions

Handicap for this tournament will be based on 80% of the team total and the scratch. Please see the chart below:

#### League Standing Sheets

- League standing sheets must accompany all entries.
- Averages as of February 28th, 2026 of the current season will be used.
- Sport averages may be used only if it is the bowler's sole league and must be noted on the entry.
- Sport averages will be converted per USBC guidelines.

## Tournament Format

- Each event consists of three (3) games bowled on one pair of lanes.

- Bowlers must remain in the listed entry lineup order.

### Teams

- Four (4) bowlers per team
- All boys, all girls, or mixed

### Doubles

- Two (2) bowlers per team
- All boys, all girls, or mixed
- Doubles entry requires Singles entry

### Singles

- One (1) bowler
- Singles entry requires Doubles entry

### Substitutes

- Substitutes are permitted.
- Division reclassification may occur.
- Substitution forms must be completed one (1) hour prior to squad start time.

### Tardy Bowlers

- Late bowlers must begin in the current frame.
- Missed frames receive a zero (0).
- Teams refusing to start on time will forfeit declined games.
- No blind scores allowed.

### Coaches, Captains & Parents

- Must check in 60 minutes prior to squad start time.
- TNBA and USBC proof required at check-in.
- Coaches are responsible for all award applications.

### Scholarship & Awards

- 100% of award fees returned
- Awards issued as SMART scholarships
- Ties are broken by highest actual pinfall
- Championship ties decided by total actual pinfall

## Attire

### Appropriate Attire Includes:

- Bowling jerseys, polos, T-shirts
- Slacks, shorts, skirts or skorts (must extend past fingertip length)
- TNBA, TNBA Senate or ERJT Logo

### Prohibited:

- Sweatpants
- Ripped or torn clothing
- Tank tops
- Headgear
- Electronic or phone devices during play

⚠ Dress code violations may result in disqualification.

### Bowling Etiquette & Conduct

- Bowlers must remain in the settee area unless excused.
- No smoking, food, or drinks in the settee area.
- No outside food or drinks permitted in the bowling center.
- No coaching allowed in the settee area.
- Parents and coaches must remain in spectator areas.
- Rule violations or falsified entries in immediate disqualification with no refund.

### Final Authority

- The Tournament Committee reserves all rights.
- Decisions are final unless appealed under USBC
