- Entries Close midnight March 16, 2024. Full entry fee must accompany all entries. All entries must be complete and legible. Team
 Captains must completely fill out the information portion. NO NICKNAMES name must match USBC card for
 average verification. If the name cannot be verified bowler bowls with 210 NO
 EXCEPTIONS!!
- Personal checks will not be accepted. Fees may be paid by bank checks, money orders, certified checks, Tournament Club
 checks or ZELLE: LATNBASENATE@GMAIL.COM. (Cash is accepted for onsite Doubles sign ups)

3. Team composition 2/2.(2 men/2women) Doubles 1/1 (1man/1woman)

4. MIXED DOUBLES TOURNAMENT bowlers may sign up at the Tournament site one hour prior to squad time. Singles is a multiple participation event, but you can CASH ONLY ONCE WITH THE HIGHEST SCORE.

5. Any entry form improperly filled out, or missing averages or insufficient fees, will be returned to the sender.

6. The Tournament will be operated under strict compliance with TNBA and USBC rules.

7. This Tournament is sanctioned by TNBA and USBC. The Tournament is open only to TNBA and USBC members. Non TNBA members may qualify for entry by paying unattached membership fees of Thirty (\$30.00) dollars at the Tournament site. Non USBC members may qualify for entry by paying the unattached membership fees of Thirty (\$30.00) dollars.

8. HANDICAP for this Tournament will be 80% of 840 for Team entries and 80% of 420 for Mixed Doubles and 80% of 210 for Singles.

- Substitutes shall be permitted at the DISCRETION of the Tournament Director, and he/she MUST bowl in the position of the original bowler. All Rules and Regulations herein shall also apply to substitutes. Once a substitute has started to bowl, the substitute must finish the event being bowled.
- 10. AVERAGES Bowlers must use highest 2year USBC sanctioned average based on a minimum of 21 games as of 2022-23 or 2021-22. If neither of the 2 seasons use highest current sanctioned average of 21 games or more as of January 31, 2024 with league sheet verification. LEAGUE SHEET MUST BE PRESENTED AT TIME OF BOWLING. All others must bowl scratch (210). No Summer Averages or Sports Averages used but Challenge Averages will be used. All bowlers must report adjusted averages used by their Tournament Clubs and Tournament rerates for possible adjustment of average used for this tournament. If adjusted/rerate average is higher than book average, that higher average must be used in this tournament. USBC rule 319A applies for this tournament. USBC rules 319d is waived for this Tournament. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE BOWLER TO VERIFY HIS/HER AVERAGE IS CORRECT. The Tournament Director has the right to adjust any average prior to bowling.
- 11. If a Bowler submits an average higher than his/her true average, they must bowl with the lesser handicap and no additional pins may be given to him/her. If a Bowler submits an average that is less than his/her true average, he/she shall forfeit all money (he/she helped to win. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his/her average whether originally submitted by the Bowler, his/her team Captain, or others. Failure to use the proper average or make corrections before completion of the first game shall disqualify scores if submitted average is lower than actual average. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average.
- 12. A Bowler whose high league average is 210 or less shall submit himself/ herself for re-rating and shall be re-rated before entering the Tournament in accordance with USBC Rule 319c. Any bowler whose average is 10 pins or more higher in current league must use that average if it higher than submitted average. USBC rule 319A applies.

13. Bowlers must report winnings of \$600 or more in the past 12 months or be subject to disqualification.

- 14. Errors in scoring must be reported to the Tournament Director's Office within twenty- four (24) hours after the games are bowled.
- 15. Tardy Bowlers will start in the frame being bowled with zero (0) being given for each missed frame. Any Bowler not ready to bowl when it is his or her turn shall receive a zero (0) for that frame. No blind scores allowed MISSING BOWLERS RECEIVE ZERO (0).
- 16. NO REFUNDS. Fees after being received will not be refunded except in dire emergency, such as an employees strike, employees lockout, fire or anything else management has no control over.
- 17. One hundred percent (100. %) of Prize Fund will be returned in the event for which it is collected. There will be at least one prize for every 6 entries in each event. The Tournament Committee shall post all results within 7 days of conclusion of the tournament.
- 18. NO PBA, WPBA or any Professional Tour Card holder allowed to bowl in this Tournament.

19. No hats or caps allowed during Tournament play.

 The Tournament Committee reserves the right to disqualify and/or refuse any bowler not in compliance with the rules of the Tournament.
